IHWT THOROUGHBRED CLUB WORKING HUNTER SERIES QUALIFIER

FOR RETRAINED RACEHORSES 2018

The IHWT Thoroughbred Club Retrained Racehorse Working Hunter Series

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, any height. Riders must be 16 years or over by Jan 1st in current year. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle. Horses should be plaited. Front boots of a plain colour may be worn during the jumping phase. Fences in the IHWT Retrained Working Hunter Series should have a minimum height/spread of 80cm and a maximum height/spread of 90cm. Fences to be a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 and will have a natural appearance. Will be judged as per the Novice working hunter class that it is run within at Wexford equestrian. No change of rider or tack to be allowed between the jumping phase and ridden phase except for the removal of boots and/or martingales. Highest placed racehorse will be identified 1-4th place (you may be given a badge to identify the TB in the class).

Winner and Reserve at each qualifier go forward to the Final /championship. If either of these has previously qualified the qualification may be passed down the line at the judges discretion.

All entries **MUST** have registered with The IHWT Thoroughbred Club (registration is free at www.ihwt.ie) and include their registration number on entry form. Horses must be retired and have **RACED in a point to point or on the racetrack**. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the show Rules and Regulations from time to time in force.

Winner and Reserve go forward to the Final /championship. If either of these has previously qualified the qualification may be passed down the line at the judges discretion.

All entries **MUST** have registered with The IHWT Thoroughbred Club (registration is free at www.ihwt.ie) and include their registration number on entry form Horses must be retired and have **RACED in a point to point or on the racetrack**. All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the show Rules and Regulations from time to time in force'

The Champion from the Final will qualify for the Retraining of Racehorses (RoR) National Championship Show at Aintree, UK in August - to compete in *Either in the RoR Elite Showing Series Final or in The RoR Amateur Ridden Show series Final.

**To complete in the RoR Elite Showing Series Final, the horse must have raced in Great Britain.*

If the horse has not run in GB, provided an amateur showing person rides him, he is eligible to go in the RoR Amateur Ridden Show series Final. Costs of travel to Aintree and accommodation for horse and riders is sponsored through the IHWT TB Club.
