

Rules Wexford Ec Primary schools league 2025/26- see Equestrian Interschools Ireland for all other relevant rules – These are specific to our Primary league and Ind classes

- *Teams can consist of 3 members or 4 members (with discard score)**
- * Teams may consist of 55cm & 75cm riders(YOU must enter at the height that you regularly jump at or are jumping ind competitions on the day) and can move up during the year but not down without permission from Wexford ec. But these exceptions will jump HC – eg Old/green ponies**
- * Jump off of 2 riders (nominate your riders at the height you want)- must be height jumped In the competition or 2 phase all riders are timed in the second round and top 3 eligible times are taken ie the second round that counts for team.**
- * Prizes will be rosettes on the day for 1-3rd teams for all dates with prizes on the day and final as stand alone competitions however the Final will have rosettes on the day only and Trophies & medals etc for league winners overall and Perpetual Trophy to winning school**
- * Points for placings 1st school 10 points, 2nd school 9 points etc to 10th place**
- * Points are allocated to the team name/ school and must keep the same name/ team if mixed during the league/riders may change within the teams only if they are from same schools**
- * Schools MUST make up teams from within a school first before sourcing outside members. Should they fall short of the allocated team of 3 or 4 they may source from another school ONLY if that school also has limited riders – on no occasion should their be Multiple mixed teams with the same school riders ending up on different teams. This is a schools competition and must embrace the concept of school participation.**
- * winning school/ team name will be the most overall points over the league dates and points & half at the final**
- * All riders Must be members of Interschools Ireland prior to competing on the day**
- * All judging is run under Sji rulebooks for interschools competitions – specific interschool rule updates can be found on the EII website also to clarify but the sji rule book has a comprehensive list of rules regarding participation / health and safety etc please ensure to be familiar with it prior to competing.**
- * Ponies ridden on a team can not be entered on any other team on the day unless siblings**
- * Ponies on a team MAY be shared by riders ONLY if they are siblings**
- * Second ponies May be ridden by riders in IND competitions but NOT in team competitions**
- * Riders must compete at the team heights in IND competitions and can only compete at a lower height HC out of competition declared on the day before the competition starts for schooling purposes. Those who wish to move up during the year may compete and be assessed after as those moving up will be expected to compete at that height for the remainder of the season in both team and ind competitions**
- * Ponies can only be ridden max 3 times during the day by a rider**
- * Riders can only enter a team event and 3 ind classes but on different ponies and in the same or higher classes**
- * Riders may only ride 2 ponies in any one ind competition on the day.**

We ask people to self enforce these rules as we are not in a position to monitor all riders however should an objection be lodged by any competitor they must submit this at Reception on the day immediately with name/ contact info and query, before the results of the competition are announced, Should an objection be in relation to results they must be lodged within 30 min of the competition finishing . Any objections will be addressed where possible on the day. We reserve the right to alter any results posted/ league tables or points as we determine after an enquiry, However Prizes or rosettes awarded on the day to children will not be altered in the interest of the children affected.

**In the interest of safety we highly recommend back protectors are worn by all primary school competitors
